You might have most of these items in your art bag! This supply list will help compile a useful grouping to paint with watercolors.

First off let us talk about PAINT. I will be using the Dr. Ph. Martin's Hydrus Watercolors. These paints come in 1 ounce and 1/2 ounce bottles in a 12 color set. The set 1 with 12 colors are perfect for establishing a base. Also, I will have plenty of paint you can try before you buy! Now you have the paints, you will need a palette. A palette can be a white enamel pan, or ones at the supply store that have individual wells to put in the paint. A white plate from Target works. You choose.

BRUSHES

There are many watercolor brushes to choose. I like the Lowe-Cornell brushes they are very nice. The best sizes to start with are the round brushes. One brush size 12 or 14, another one size 10 or 8, a smaller one size 6, 5, 4, or 3. Now a brush for laying a wash. A large 1 1/2 inch brush, or an 1 inch brush. If you have watercolor brushes just bring what you have in your supplies. If you have to buy a brush go with a #1 O or #12 round and a brush for a wash.

MISCELLANEOUS SUPPLIES

A water mister I like the Misto Mister. There will be plenty at class if you do not have one. Other supplies from around the house are a sponge, plastic wrap, clear scotch tape, Masking tape, Kleenex, paper towels, and a container to put water in for painting. This container can be an old plastic cup or bowl. Put in an old hair dryer, this will speed the drying process. If you have any other painting supplies bring them.

PAPER

Fabrino Artistico 300 lb., rough, cold press, and even hot press. Once you try this great paper you will want to continue to use it for all paintings. A block of watercolor paper is another option. These sheets of watercolor paper are secured together making it easy to work. If you have other quality paper bring it to class.
