### WATERCOLOR SUPPLY LIST

Here is my recommended watercolor art supply list for my classes and workshops. But if you have watercolor supplies bring them and I can take a look. You can find links to all the supplies, just go here <http://bit.ly/art-watercolor-supplies>.

#### PAINT (tube paints only)

*Recommended brands: QoR, Holbein, Winsor & Newton Professional (NOT Cotman), Blick Artists' Watercolors, or Royal Talens: Van Gogh, or Rembrandt\**

Cobalt Blue  
Ultramarine Blue  
Manganese Blue  
Raw Sienna  
Burnt Sienna  
Brown Madder or Alizarin Crimson  
Sap Green  
Cadmium Yellow Medium

#### GOUACHE

Winsor & Newton Designers,  
Permanent White

#### BRUSHES

I prefer real hair watercolor brushes if you can afford them.

MEEDEN Squirrel hair cat's tongue shape paint brushes-3 piece set for watercolors (these brushes can replace the 1" flat and #10 round )

or

1" flat brush

#10 round real hair watercolor brush

#4 or #6 round brush

• 1" flat brush

#### PALETTE

• MEEDEN Airtight leakproof watercolor palette travel paint tray. I personally prefer this palette because it's easy to transport.

#### PAPER

2 sheet Arches bright white or natural white

watercolor 300# paper: 22"x 30" – cold press\*\*

or

2 sheet Fabriano 300# watercolor paper: 22"x 30" – cold press\*\*

or

2 sheet Indigo handmade artpapers 640 gsm, 22" x 30"\*\*

#### ADDITIONAL SUPPLIES

18" x 24" x 3/4" drawing board

3/4" masking tape (NO colored tape)

2B pencil or an ebony pencil

Kneaded eraser

X-Acto knife

Paper towels

Small water spray bottle

Sponge

Water container

Old toothbrush

OPTIONAL: Tabletop easel\*\*\*

\*DO NOT BUY hobby store brands

\*\*Cut full sheets of watercolor paper into quarters

\*\*\*If you can't afford a tabletop easel prop-up your painting board with a roll of toweling paper
