



Supplies that are supplied by the instructor:

- Gel Plates
- Brayers
- Artist tissue paper
- Extra copy paper
- Printmaking paper
- Cardstock
- Glassine
- Extra Paint
- Extra polymer medium and collage adhesives
- Oil pastels and crayons
- Stencils and masks
- Brushes
- Charcoal
- Extra texture tools
- Scissors
- Spray bottles
- Plastic notebook dividers
- Extra palette paper
- Extra baby wipes

Student supplies needing to bring:

- Substrates and Paper
***140 lb or heavier watercolor paper. Hot press paper. At least 2 packs of 12. Size is your choice as these will be the substrate you will be applying collage papers and paint. One I like is <https://www.dickblick.com/items/fabriano-studio-watercolor-pad-9-x-12-300-gsm-hot-press-12-sheets/>
- Copy paper. A half ream should be good but I will bring extra
- Acrylic paint

Best suggestions I use are listed first and you don't need all:

Golden fluids or High Flow acrylic paints (Transparent colors such as Azo Gold, Shading Gray, Payne's Gray, Phthalo Blue etc.)

Amsterdam (white, titanium buff, black, and colors of choice)

- Liquitex Soft Body or Basics, High Flow
- Chalk paint
- Deco Art***Metallic acrylic paints if you like. Metallic paint is gorgeous with the gel plate!

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ART WORKSHOP RETREAT

- Note: Make sure to bring a white, off white or buff, black, shading grey (Golden), Azo Gold (Golden), a brown, and the three primary colors, yellow, blue and red.
- Polymer gel medium:
A fluid matte medium or gloss medium (fluid not heavy) for pulling papers.
- Collage Glue
A collage glue medium such as a gloss gel medium, matte medium.
Yes paste, Modge Podge.
Note: Yes, paste is my preferred due to low water content with less paper buckling, but can be pricey, so bring what you can afford or that you have tried successfully.
UHU glue stick or other glue stick is also a great option.
- Mark Making
Mark making pens, pencils and artist crayons (you don't need all) Ideas such as
Posca pens (recommended) Caron d'ache artist crayons, Stabilo All Colored Marking Pencils, Sharpie etc.

Other Supplies

- Magazines. Note: bring a few
- Texture tools you may have around the house such as: Bubble wrap, string, rubber bands, pieces of cling wrap, corrugated cardboard, the sky is the limit!
- Optional Journal for ideas, small studies, taking notes.
- Water container
- Palette paper
- Paper towels 2 rolls
- Various sizes of paint brushes
- Baby wipes (2- cheap is fine)
- Cheap cosmetic sponges
- Metal ruler
- Small hand sanitizer for cleaning the plate.

Note: If you are coming with a friend you can share some of the supplies!

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
