Yeliseyev Signature watercolor brushes: No 8, 12 and 14 (synthetic, all round)

Yeliseyev Signature Sword liner

### WATERCOLOR PAINTS

Cad yellow medium, yellow ochre, yellow ochre gold, burnt sienna, burnt umber, transparent oxide brown (van dyke brown), sepia, alizarin crimson, cadmium red light, Yeliseyev indigo, cobalt teal (turquoise), cerulean blue, cobalt blue, ultramarine blue, royal amethyst (dioxazine violet), Titanium white

Paint palette 10" x 12" or bigger with at least three separate flat mixing areas
