- Sewing needle with eye hole big enough to get embroidery floss through, yet can go through beads if you choose to add to your totem.
- Thimble
- Needle nose pliers
- Round nose pliers
- Embroidery floss
- Paint brushes, various sizes. No larger than a 2"
- Found objects ( I like rusty metals I find while out walking).

- Glue. Yes Paste is recommended for ephemera and fabric, but you can bring along any other glue such as Mod Podge, Tacky Glue, Elmers Glue All, Gorilla (not the expandable one) etc.
- E6000 recommended for attaching any metals or objects
- Baby wipes
- Water cup or jar
- Paper towels

**Optional Things to Bring:**

- I will bring plenty of fabric but if you have special fabrics you want to incorporate, then bring it along!
- I am bringing along molds for the clay but if you have any you would like to bring along that would be fine.
- Photos you would like to incorporate
- Ephemera
- Dried botanicals
- Any other elements you can think of!
