## ART WORKSHOP RETREAT

### Janet Nunn Watercolors Supply List

You might have most of these items in your art bag!

This supply list will help compile a useful grouping to paint with watercolors. First off, let us talk about paint. I will be using the Dr. Ph. Martin's Hydrus Watercolors. These paints come in 1-ounce and 1/2-ounce bottles in a 12-color set. Set 1 with 12 colors is perfect for establishing a base. [www.docmartins.com](http://www.docmartins.com) carries the paints. **I will have plenty of paint you can try before you buy!**

Now you have the paints, you will need a palette. A palette can be a white enamel pan, or ones at the supply store that have individual wells to put in the paint. A white plate from Target works. You choose.

**Brushes** There are many watercolor brushes to choose. the brushes I use are the Princeton Velvetouch. The best sizes to start with are the round brushes. One brush size 12 or 14, another one size 10 or 8, and a smaller one size 6, or 3. Now a brush for laying a wash. A large 1 1/2 inch brush, or an 1 inch brush. **If you have brushes, great bring them to class. I will have a few brushes to try if you need them.**

**Miscellaneous supplies** .Supplies from around the house are clear scotch tape or Masking tape, sissors, Kleenex, paper towels, wax paper, plastic wrap and a container to put water in for painting. This container can be an old plastic cup or bowl. A Misto water mister is perfect for wetting paper. Put in an old hair dryer, this will speed the drying process.

The paper I will be using is 300 lb Fabrinano Artisticco. If you have a block of watercolor paper this is great. A block is where there are several pieces of paper tacked together on a block you paint. **This paper will be supplied for you.**

**Sketching supplies** A sketch book for drawing and for taking notes. A #2 pencil for sketching on the watercolor paper. A black fine-point sharpie is nice for sketching and for use in some paintings.
